Who is Eligible?

A student who is/was placed at any time in foster care or out-of-home care during the current OR previous state fiscal year may be eligible (The state fiscal year runs from July 1 to June 30.).

A Child in Foster Care

A child in foster care is defined by the following:

"Foster care" means care provided a child in a foster family or boarding home, group home, agency boarding home, child care institution, or any combination thereof, as defined by s. 39.01(30).

A Child in Out-of-Home Care

A child in out-of-home care placement is defined by the following:

"Out-of-home" means a placement outside of the home of the parents or a parent, as defined by s. 39.01(55) which is further defined as the placement of a child in licensed and non-licensed settings, arranged and supervised by the department or contracted service provider, outside of the home of the parent, as defined by DCF Rule: 65C-30.001 Definitions. (80).

Documentation from the state of Florida that validates that the child meets the definition of s. 39.01(30) or 39.01(55) and specifies the amount of support provided by the state for the benefit of the child must be submitted.
